Notice of Race

Friday June 23/Saturday June 24

Rules: This regatta will be governed by good sportsmanship, Transport Canada Rules of the Road for sharing of waterways and the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.

Eligibility: All GYC Member-owned keel boats. Keel boats from other Lake Winnipeg yacht clubs may also participate.

Divisions: Flying Sails and Non-Flying Sails.

Awards: 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each Division.

Registration: Thursday June 22 – 8:00pm to 9:00pm GYC club deck.

Skippers Meeting: 9:00pm. Thursday June 22, GYC club deck.

Start: Pursuit start. Day 1 - First Boat at 8:00am Friday June 23.
Day 2 - First Boat at 8:30am Saturday June 24.

Fee: \$20.00 per boat. You must also pay a docking fee at Gull Harbour. Speak with the Harbour Master upon arrival. Hotel, ATM and showers are available at Gull Harbor.

Breakfast: The restaurant at Gull Harbour is open on Saturday morning for breakfast.

Delay: In case of very poor weather conditions, the race will run Saturday and Sunday or Friday and Sunday.

Course:

Day 1: Start - A line between the Gimli Harbour light (red light) and a buoy marker.

Finish - A line at 270 degrees to the Gull Harbour lighthouse at the point. (N 51.11.500°).

Day 2: Start - A line at 270 degrees to the Gull Harbour lighthouse at the point. (N 51.11.500°).

Finish - A line between the Gimli Harbour light house (red light) and a buoy marker.

Scoring: PHRF Time on Distance (TOD) with a pursuit start. Each boat will receive a start time based on their handicap. Each boat will then take a finish time when crossing the finish line.

What do I need to know to race? – You will be given a start time for Friday and a start time for Saturday. You need to write down the time you finish on both days. As well you need to write down the time you cross the Pearsons reef marker on Day 1. The finish times need to be given to the race director in person or by email after the race. **Deadline for submission of race times is noon, Monday June 12.**

Stay to the outside (towards center of lake) of the DD2 marker off Smokey point and avoid Pearsons Reef.

DD2 – 50.56.60°N, 96.47.00°W **Pearsons Reef** – 50.57.50°N, 96.41.80°W
