Notice of Race
Saturday, August 15, 2020

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of Sail Canada, this Notice of Race and the rules of The Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Lake Winnipeg and Lake of the Woods as amended by the Gimli Yacht Club.

Eligibility: All GYC Member-owned keel boats. Keel boats from other Lake Winnipeg yacht clubs may also participate.

Divisions: Flying Sails and Non-Flying Sails.

Awards: 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each Division.

Registration: Please register at <https://www.eventbrite.ca/e/gimli-leukemia-cup-regatta-registration-115262238458> If online registration is not possible, there will be limited in person registration on Saturday, August 15, 2020 from 0900-1000 at GYC.

Skippers Meeting: Due to COVID-19 restrictions there will be no Skippers Meeting. Coordinates and instructions will be posted at the club no later than 1000 on Saturday, August 15, 2020

Start: Pursuit start. First boat starts at 1100.

Fee: A minimum \$20 tax deductible donation per person to the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society of Canada, due before 1000 on race day. If necessary, collection envelopes will be provided on the morning of the regatta, but online registration and donations are preferred. Tax receipts will be sent to the individual(s) named online or on the collection envelope. Cash, cheques, Interac, Visa, and MasterCard will be accepted.

Race Director: Charlie Burns – Liquor Box – cburns120@outlook.com, 204-799-3366. If this is your first pursuit race of the year send me your boat name and boat type so that you can be properly handicapped ahead of time.

Course:

10 mile course

Start/Finish - A line between the Gimli Harbour light (red light) and a buoy marker.

Scoring: PHRF Time on Distance (TOD) with a pursuit start. Each boat will receive a start time based on their handicap. Each boat will then take a finish time when crossing the finish line listing the boat ahead and the boat behind.

What do I need to know to race? – You will be given a start time. You need to write down the time you finish. The finish time with the boat ahead and the boat behind needs to be communicated to the Race Director. Text him at 204-799-3366. Prompt finishing info is extremely helpful otherwise finishing orders are impossible to get correct. **Deadline for submission of race times is 1600, Saturday August 15, 2020.**
