NOTICE OF RACE

[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the Protest Committee. This changes RRS 64.1.

[NP] denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for a protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

2 Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta, for **Centennial Cup** competitors, is open to all dinghy, including but not limited to Optimist, Laser, Laser 2, C420, 29er, Albacore and 2.4mR classes, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7
- 3.2 The **Manitoba Laser Masters Championships** are open to all boats of the Laser class including Standard, Radial, and 4.7.
- 3.3 The regatta, for the **Manitoba Laser Masters Championship**, is open to all boats of the Laser class whose skippers have reached the age of 35 by the regatta start date. Competitors shall be assigned to the following age divisions based on their age on the first day of the regatta:
 - Apprentice – 35-44 years of age
 - Master – 45-54 years of age
 - Grand Master – 55-64 years of age
 - Great Grand Master – 65+ years of age

3.4 All **Manitoba Laser Masters Championship** competitors must be current members of ILCA North America or their equivalent national Laser Class Association. Non-members can join the class by completing registration online at www.laser.org.

3.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online form using the following link:

Registration between August 22nd and August 27th will not include dinner.

Late Registration may be made in person on Friday, August 28th, between 1900 - 2000 hrs, or on Saturday, August 29th, between 0830 hrs – 0900 hrs. There will be a late registration charge of \$10.00. (Registration Fee less \$25 dinner, plus \$10 a person late fee)

5.1 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1430.

6 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

7 Venue

Racing will take place on the west side of Lake Winnipeg, outside the town of Gimli, Manitoba.

8 Courses

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

8.1 The Open race will consist of a windward/leeward course with a reach finish.

8.2 The Optimist race will consist of a windward/leeward course with a downwind finish.

9 Penalty System

9.1 Appendix P will apply as changed by NOR 8.2 and 8.3.

9.2 RRS P2.3 will not apply and RRS P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.

9.3 For the 29er class RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10 Scoring

10.1 The number of races scheduled is seven. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11 Charter Boats

We have a limited supply of charter boats. Charter boats are available on a first come, first served basis with preference given to members of the Gimli Yacht Club in good standing. Contact Kayden Polachek at manager@gimliyachtclub.com. The charter agreement is outside the responsibility of the organizing authority. Non GYC Members may charter an Albacore or a Laser for \$75 for the weekend.

12 Safety *[DP][NP]*

12.1 All 29ers, Lasers, Radials, 4.7s, Albacores, and other dinghies must have a tow line, of minimum 10 metres length and 7mm diameter fixed to their mast. Competitors may not use other lines from running rigging for this purpose. C420s and Optimist classes are required to have tow lines in accordance with their class rules.

12.2 The Preamble to RRS Part 4 and RRS 40 is changed to require personal flotation devices (PFD's) to be worn at all times when afloat, except when changing clothing.

13 Prizes will be awarded as follows:

Laser Apprentice Master, Laser Master, Laser Grand Master, Laser Great Grand Master, First overall Laser Master sailor, First overall Laser, First overall Open, First overall Opti

14 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for sickness, for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 Insurance [DP][NP]

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. The organizing authority does not accept any responsibility for verifying that a boat has valid third-party liability insurance.

17 Rights to Use Name and Likeness

In participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition in this events in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the events without compensation.
