

Gimli Yacht Club Wednesday Night Racing 2025 The Organizing Authority is the Gimli Yacht Club (GYC) June through August 2025 Gimli, Manitoba, Canada

Notice of Race (NoR)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1.

1 RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available on the Gimli Yacht Club website at https://gimliyachtclub.com/on-the-lake/racing prior to racing.

3 **COMMUNICATION**

3.1 The official notice board is located on the East windows of the South building.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The Wednesday Night event series is open to all GYC keelboats.
- 4.2 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees prior to first day of racing.
- 4.3 Each boat may be required to provide a volunteer crew member or other volunteer to serve on the Race Committee for a minimum of one race.

5 FEES AND REGISTRATION

- 5.1 Boat Registration Fee: **\$100**. For 2025 there are no additional fees for crew, but you must send an email of all non-GYC member crew's first and last name prior to the race night to manager@gimliyachtclub.com
- 5.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online at https://shop.gimliyachtclub.com/collections/racing
- All boats shall calculate their Maximum Crew Contingent as explained in the registration (See page 6 of this notice). Boats shall not race with crew exceeding the Maximum Crew Contingent. Maximum Crew contingent shall be defined as the

maximum crew a boat shall have on board for any race during the series. The maximum crew contingent is restricted by 5.3 and the following:

6.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal for Races 1 to 8 is 18:55 hours.

The scheduled time of the first warning signal for Races 9 to 12 is 18:25 hours.

7 **VENUE**

7.1 Racing will take place on the West side of Lake Winnipeg, outside the town of Gimli, Manitoba.

8 **COURSES**

8.1 There will be windward leeward courses with an upwind finish, as well as triangle courses offered alternatively.

9 **PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 9.1 RRS Appendix P will apply as changed by NoR 10.2.
- 9.2 RRS P2.3 will not apply and RRS P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Tune Up Race on June 4th is not counted towards the series score. The number of races scheduled is twelve (12).
- The scoring system will follow Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing.

5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When from 6 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When 9 to 11 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- (d) When 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 3 worst scores.

11 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

11.1 Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the Series except with, and according to the terms of permission of the race committee. The intent of this rule is that all competitors wet sail their boats all summer. Competitors may lift to clean the hull.

12 RISK STATEMENT

12.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in

the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

13 **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance stipulated to cover racing.
