



GYC 2026 Membership Application and Guidelines

The Board of Directors of the Gimli Yacht Club thanks you for showing interest in our Club. By joining the Club, you will be a member of the largest boating organization on Lake Winnipeg. The GYC offers many opportunities for both recreational and competitive boating activities that can be enjoyed by sailors of all age groups. Depending upon your interests as they pertain to boating, we offer a number of different membership options, all of which are detailed below, followed by our membership application form.

1. General Information

- New memberships received starting August 1st carry over to the following year
- By paying your fees you are accepting, and agreeing to abide by, the Club's Constitution, Bylaws and Code of Conduct, and all Club rules and regulations
- Members are responsible for tracking volunteer hours on the GYC member's website
- Membership renewal invoices emailed not later than April 1st
- No refunds after July 1st
- No charge for summer outdoor dinghy storage on grass.
- To store any type of dinghy at the Club or dinghy area, owners must be a Senior or Youth member of the GYC, and check with Registrar that space is available
- A GYC sticker (available from the Treasurer) must be secured to all dinghies and boat trailers
- Names must be clearly visible on dock boxes and other items stored at the Club (but not in your storage locker)
- No storage of dinghies or dock boxes in the South Building from June through August
- Individual guest or guest families are permitted 3 times per year
- Senior (Single, Couple, Family), Youth, or Wednesday Night Racing (WNR) membership is required in order to participate in the WNR Race Program

2. Membership Categories

I) Single Membership

- Defined as a Senior Member 18 years of age and older
- Includes full access to facilities, equipment and programs
- May serve as a Director of the GYC if so elected, and is entitled to one vote
- Includes membership to Sail Manitoba and Sail Canada
- Requires 7.5 volunteer hours

II) Couple Membership

- Defined as two Senior Members
- Includes full access to facilities, equipment and programs
- May serve as a Director of the GYC if so elected and is entitled to two votes
- Includes two memberships to Sail Manitoba and Sail Canada
- Requires 15 volunteer hours

III) Family Membership

- Defined as parent(s) and their dependent children
- Includes full access to facilities, equipment and programs



- May serve as a Director of the GYC if so elected and is entitled to one or two votes (depending on the number of Senior members)
- Includes one (or two) memberships to Sail Manitoba and Sail Canada
- Additional memberships to Sail Manitoba / Sail Canada may be purchased for WNR as required
- Requires hours 7.5 volunteer hours per Senior member

IV) Youth Membership

- Defined as a Restricted Member from 6 to 24 years of age and is a full-time student. If under the age of 18, signature of parent or guardian required.
- Youth members under 14 years of age require the supervision of a Senior Member
- Includes full access to GYC facilities, equipment and programs
- May not serve as a Director of the GYC, and has no voting privileges
- No access to the Club crane
- Includes one membership to Sail Manitoba and Sail Canada

V) Wednesday Night Racing (WNR) Membership

- Defined as a Restricted Member participating in the WNR Race Program
- The Wednesday Night Racing Membership was created to make it easy for non-GYC members to race in the 12-race series, have insurance coverage and use the Club on Wednesdays
- Includes full use of facilities during racing events on Wednesday nights only
- Does not include access to the Club crane and storage privileges
- Cannot serve as a Director of the GYC and has no voting privileges
- All WNRs must have proof of their Sail Manitoba Membership, if at another club.
- A Sail Manitoba membership may be purchased at registration if proof is unavailable.
- WNRs are not eligible to sail in Pursuit Races
- A Wednesday Night Racing membership requires race management volunteering

VI) Social Membership

- Defined as a Restricted Member and is intended to permit people to take part in Club social activities without the commitment of Senior membership. It allows participation in official social events at the GYC, as well as casual socializing, but does not permit full use of the clubhouse or its amenities. Restrictions of the Social Membership include:
- No access to showers, kitchen, BBQs, or ice machine, except during scheduled social events
- No access to the Club crane or equipment
- No voting or guest privileges
- No storage privileges
- Not eligible to race in a GYC race other than as a guest.
- Cannot be combined with other membership types except WNR.
- Does not include membership to Sail Manitoba or Sail Canada
- A Social Membership requires no volunteer hours
